OLD YOU KNOW!

Capon Bridge Water Department is governed by the rules of the WV Public Service Commission.

Per WV PSC Water Rule 3.3:

- The "due date" is considered the day that the utility <u>mails</u> the bill. This will be the 6th of the month unless it falls on a weekend, then bills will be mailed out the preceding business day. Didn't receive your bill? Call our office for your balance before the due date.
- The "latest pay date" is the last date that the payment can be made without incurring a late payment penalty. This will be the 26th of the month unless it falls on a weekend, then the latest pay date will be the following business day.
- Any bill that is not paid within 20 days of the mail date is considered delinquent. Per PSC rules, payments must be received in the office by the "latest pay date" to avoid late penalty. Postmark or initiate date are not recognized.
- For your convenience, payments may be made online at <u>www.townofcaponbridgewv.gov</u> until 11:59 p.m. on the "latest pay date" or dropped in our night drop box any time <u>before</u> the office opens on the following business day to be considered timely.
- Payments made from a bank's online payment system <u>must be received in our office</u> by the "latest pay date". Consult your bill paying service for their recommended number of days for payments to reach our office. Most check processing centers require a 4-7 business day turnaround time.

REMINDER: PAY BY 26TH OF MONTH
